SUBJECT: NRCC's Initial 2024 Advertising Reservation



TOPLINE

In 2023, the NRCC set a goal to expand the House Republican Majority by recruiting top tier candidates in Democrat-held seats, while at the same time shoring up our most vulnerable members. Those off-year efforts have paid off as the NRCC's Independent Expenditure (IE) team prepares to reserve **\$45.7 million in television and digital advertising** across 22 battleground districts. This reservation includes a significant investment in both digital and Spanish-language advertising.

True to our goal of expanding the majority, 13 of 22 districts in this reservation are currently held by Democrats. By contrast, a vast majority of the DCCC's initial reservation is dedicated to defending their embattled members.

Over one-quarter of the NRCC's initial reservation is dedicated to the five Trump districts currently held by Democrats: AK-AL, ME-02, OH-09, PA-08, and WA-03. These are must-win seats for Republicans, and we're going all in because of the strength of our Republican challengers in each of these seats.

The takeaway: as Joe Biden's numbers plummet - fueled by chaos at the border, on college campuses, on community streets, and in family wallets - the map is moving toward Republicans, providing opportunities to flip seats from Alaska to Maine.


